This funding will be used to

- Build staff capacity in their understanding of the Australian Curriculum.
- Refine, review and implement a whole school Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Plan on SharePoint framed using the P-12 CARF.
- Engage regional support from the PATL to build staff capability in understanding the demands of the P-12 CARF.
- Increase staff knowledge of moderation processes through staff meeting PL and planning days using the PATL
- Teachers are assigned planning days with the HOD – Curriculum to ensure consistency of planning across the whole school.

Our initiatives include

- Extensive recruitment process for a Head of Department – Curriculum
 - Individual to have extensive knowledge of Australian Curriculum
 - Experience in working with and leading teams
 - Strategic understanding of P-12 Curriculum, assessment and reporting framework and the ability to apply this understanding in the school context.
 - Knowledge and capability of the three levels of curriculum planning to enhance teacher capability and consistency across the whole school.
